


Charles Lemon Clifford







--Sometime between 1915 and 1917 Charles was committed to a mental hospital in Osawatomie, Kansas. Grandpa C (Walter L.) said it was because his brother's wife's family wanted to prevent him from pestering them about the \$500 his brother left him in his will. Grandpa, who was living in Tulsa, Oklahoma, got him released into his custody in 1917 on the condition he take him out of Kansas.

GRIEVING AT LOSS, C, L, CLIFFORD TAKES POISON TO END LIFE

Despondent Over Loss of a Hand in Accidental Shooting

Dr. Aldrich reported this afternoon that it was a plain case of suicide and no inquest would be necessary. He stated that the strychnine had been purchased in Independence ended in failure due to quick action on the part of the fam-ity, according to the coroner. A week ago Mr. Clifford at-tempted to hang himself in the barn, while six weeks ago he made an attempt at suicide by turning on the gas in his room.



Obituary

CL Clifford committed suicide by taking strychnine, after 2 failed attempts. He had tried to hang himself the week before and had turned the gas on in his room six weeks before. He was despondent over the loss of his right hand in a shooting accident 4 months previous.
