



Letter to Virgie from Eureka Springs, Arkansas

Letter written to daughter Virgie just a month and a half before her death. Ella Cornett had been undergoing treatment at Eureka Springs, Arkansas for chronic Bright's Disease (Nephritis). My grandmother, Alice (8), and her brother Darrell (6) were with her. My grandmother always felt guilty because her mother interrupted her treatment to bring my grandmother home. My grandmother had been ill.

Mrs. J. M. Cornett Dies

Mrs. J. M. Cornett died at her home on the George Barger farm. four miles porth of Neodesha, Saturdsy, August 15, 1914, at 10 o'clock a. m. aged 42 years, 3 months and 4 days. of chronic Bright's disease. She had been in failing health for about two years, but she commenced to fall more rapidly about two months ago. Her husband had recently taken her to Excelsion Springs, Mo., and also Hot Springs, Arkansas, in the hope of improving her condition, but she continued to grow worse. Mrs. Cornett was born and reared at or pear Fall River, Kansas, and with her faurily moved to this locality several years ago. She is survived by her husband and six children. She was a truly good woman and most highly respected by all who knew her. She bore her affliction patiently and everthing possible was done to relieve her. The bereaved husband and children have the deepest sympathy of their many friends

Funeral services were held at the name Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock, conducted by Elder F. L. Petitt, pastor of the Christian church in Neodesha, and interment was made in the Neodesha cometery:
