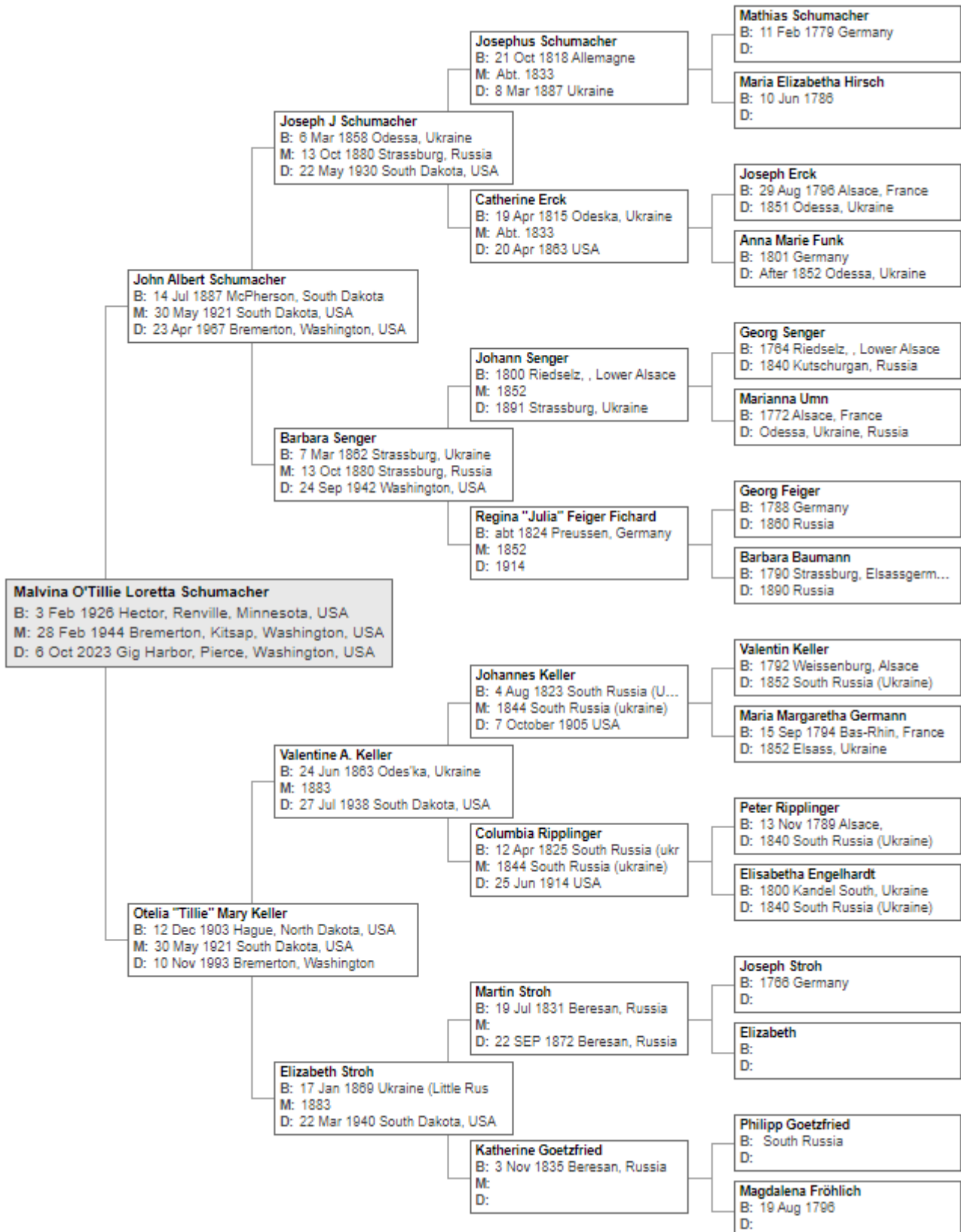


Malvina O'Tillie Schumacher Scott (1926-2023)



Malvina Schumacher was born in Hector, Renville, County, Minnesota. The daughter of John and Otelia "Tillie" (Keller) Schumacher. All her grandparents were immigrants from "Little or South Russia," the Odessa region in Ukraine. They were ethnic Germans or Alsatians, known as "Black Sea Germans," whose families had migrated to Ukraine in the late 18th Century. Her grandparents originally settled in North & South Dakota when they came to the United States.

Schumacher-Scott Nuptial Rites Read at Rectory

Simple dignity marked the wedding ceremony of Miss Malvina Schumacher, attractive daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John A. Schumacher of 195-D Magnuson Way, to Oren B. Scott, son of Mr. and Mrs. Russell Scott of 86-F Galyan Drive, last evening in the rectory of the Star of the Sea Catholic church.

The Rev. Fr. Buck read the double ring aprice at 7 o'clock before an improvised altar banked with daffodils interwoven with pastel flowers and greens. Large candelabra flanked the baskets of flowers.

For her wedding the bride was lovely in a suit of light lavender with deep lavender accessories. She wore a matching hat and corsage of gardenias. Her father gave her away in marriage.

Matron of honor was Mrs. Glen Mason, sister of the bride, who wore a dress of teal blue complemented with a corsage of pink carnations. Best man was Don Johnson.

The couple was married at the Star of the Sea rectory February 28, 1944. Mr. and Mrs. Scott met in Bremerton and made their first home in Westpark for three years. They moved to North Rainier for nine years and have lived at their present address for the past 13 years.

Scott was born in Portland, Oregon, and moved to the Skagit Valley with his parents when he was three years old. He graduated from Sedro Woolley High School in 1941.

He served an apprenticeship

at Puget Sound Naval Shipyard as a pipefitter and began in the body and fender business in 1945. He has been a used car dealer since 1949 and is the owner of Scott's ABC Motors in Bremerton. He likes to fish, hunt and play golf in his spare time.

Mrs. Scott, the former Malvina Schumacher, was born in Hector, Minnesota, and came to Bremerton when she was two years old. She is a 1943 graduate of Bremerton High School. She shares her husband's interest in golf and fishing, and also likes to sew, ski and paint.

The Scotts have three children: Mrs. Edmund Bressette, Tacoma; and Brad and Bruce Scott, both of Bremerton. They also have two grandchildren, Gary Scott and Gwen Gressette.

The celebrants also observed their anniversary with a month's vacation to Palm Desert.

Obituary

Oren B. 'Scotty' Scott

Oren B. "Scotty" Scott, 67, of Gig Harbor, died at his home Wednesday, Sept. 26, 1990. He was born Feb. 7, 1923 in Portland, Ore., and was adopted by Russell and Erma Scott of Bremerton.

He married Malvina Schumacher Feb. 28, 1944 in Bremerton. During their marriage, they have maintained homes in Bremerton; Maui, Hawaii; Lakeland Village; Lake Havasu City; and Gig Harbor.

He served an apprenticeship as a pipefitter at the Puget Sound Naval Shipyard, from 1941 to 1945. However, his true interest was in automobiles. He sold cars for Kerr Ford of Bremerton for a time, then pioneered new and used car sales in Bremerton with Scotty's ABC Motors and Scotty's Mazda, until his retirement in 1972.



Scott was an avid golfer and had been a member of the Kitsap, Wailea, Fircrest, Lakeland Village and Canterwood Golf and Country Clubs. He also enjoyed fishing, tennis, car collecting and, most of all, entertaining family and friends in his home. He often contributed food, toys and clothing to needy children at Christmas.

He is survived by his wife; two sons, Bruce Scott of Bremerton and Bradford Scott of Gig Harbor; a daughter, Pamela Bressette; four grandsons, Gary and Marc Scott, Edmond Bressette and Chris Bair; and three granddaughters, Gwen Antesberger, and Karstin and Kelsey Scott.

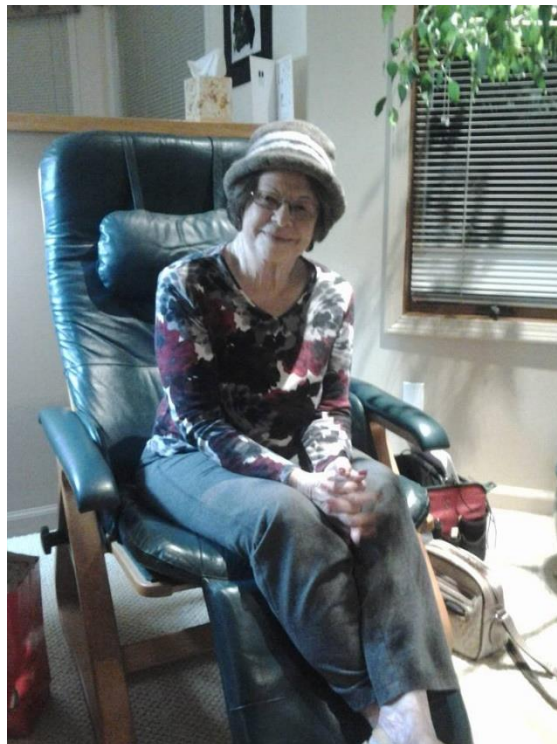
